Health, safety and management of the environment are an integral part of good science and good business practice.

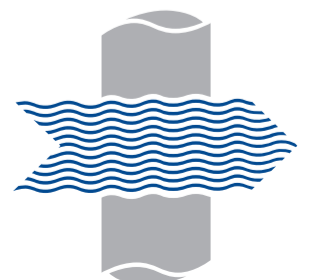
Before you start any project, experiment or work program of any size, you should first identify:

1. The hazards involved,
2. The consequences of any accidents to staff and the immediate environment, and
3. What procedures and work practices are necessary to reduce the risk to an acceptable level.

Project team discussions are a critical part of any Safety Management Plan.

Project leaders have the primary responsibility for ensuring that all team members are contributing to project safety and are informed and trained appropriately.
